Summer Day Camp - Back to the Future

June 21st - 25th - Community Life Center, Gulf Breeze

Great News! The deadline for registering for Summer Day Camp at the reduced rate of \$50 has been extended until June 1st! You don't want to miss this day camp experience! BB's, Archery, and lots of other activities are planned to make this a memorable experience, and a chance to earn lots of badges!

Come join the adventure at Cub Scout day camp. The week-long camp provides an opportunity for your scout to earn belt loops and pins in various categories including an opportunity to shoot BB's and archery every day with our range masters.

Your scout should have received a registration form in the mail. You need to mail it directly to BSA. The fee for the week will be \$50.00 if registered by **June 1st**. This fee includes all activities, a camp T-shirt and a mug.

This is a 100% volunteer-run camp so we are asking that a parent volunteer at least one day of camp if their son is attending. Child care will be available for siblings ages 3 years old and up for parents who are volunteering at the day camp for that day.

This year's camp will be held at the Community Life Center of Gulf Breeze United Methodist Church just east of the Wal-mart shopping plaza on US-98. With this new facility we will be able to offer more indoor activities away from the summer heat.

The theme for this year's camp is Back to the Future. This theme will provide lots of fun activities for the boys.

There will also be an optional Webelos Wednesday Night overnight camp-out for Webelos I and Webelos II (rising 4th and 5th graders) on Wednesday, June 23rd at the Community Life Center. A parent must camp-out with their scout. No siblings who aren't boy scouts or cub scouts.

Day camp for South Santa Rosa County not only includes our Pack 11 but also the packs from Oriole Beach Elementary School and two in Holley-Navarre. The boys will be divided into dens by age for camp. They may or may not be with their regular dens but every effort will be made to keep scouts in the same pack together.

The scouts always have a great time at this camp and it provides a great opportunity for dens to get a head start on their new requirements. Remember that the boys advance in rank at the end of the school year so they will have a new rank at summer day camp.
